



For Reflection and Discussion

Week of December 22, 2024
"The One Who Spoke With Authority"
Matthew 7:28-29

1. Reflect on Matthew 7:28-29.

What amazed the crowds who heard Jesus?

What was it that originally made Jesus compelling to you?

Is Jesus still compelling to you?

2. Reflect on how Jesus lived. How does His integrity, humility, and love stand out from other leaders today?

What, in your opinion, is the relationship between these things and authority?

- 3. Reread the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). See questions 4 and 5 for things to look for as you reread it.
- 4. Are there parts of the Sermon on the Mount that you find especially compelling?

Or, that you find especially challenging?

5. How does Jesus' authority differ from that of the religious leaders in His day?

6. Sinclair Ferguson recently said, "The greatest threat to Christmas isn't secularism or consumerism but our own boredom with the most thrilling story ever told." How can we guard against spiritual apathy during this season?

How does church attendance help you keep perspective during this time? Do other things help you keep your focus?

Consider your own interest or boredom as you read and study the below passages.

- 7. Read John 1:1-14. What do verses 1, 3, and 14 show us especially? Can you think of reasons to praise Jesus from these verses?
- 8. Read Isaiah 9:6-7. Can you think how any of these terms ("Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace") might deepen your understanding of Jesus' authority and mission?
- 9. Read Matthew 8:23-27. How do Jesus' miracles—like calming the storm—demonstrate His authority?
- 10. Read Romans 1:4. How does the resurrection prove Jesus' authority as the Son of God? In what ways does this truth encourage you to trust Him more fully?
- 11. If Jesus speaks with authority, we need to consider whether we are under His authority. Are there areas you need to surrender to His power and control?
- 12. What decision will you make today to know more about Jesus? Will you commit to reading His life in the Gospels, joining a study, or trusting Him more deeply?
