Sermon Outline: Genesis 30:25-43 Genesis: Prosperity and Providence Pastor Sean Whitenack

Where does true prosperity come from? Many seek wealth through luck, dishonesty, or personal schemes, but Scripture teaches that prosperity comes through God's blessing, wisdom, and faithful diligence. Jacob's story illustrates how God provides through hard work and trust in Him.

I. Prosperity and the Desire to Provide (Genesis 30:25-30)

Our work should glorify God and bless others (Colossians 3:23-24)

Are we working in a way that benefits others and honors God?

II. Prosperity and the Place of Hard Work (Genesis 30:31-34)

How can we demonstrate integrity, wisdom, and diligence in our workplace and responsibilities?

III. Prosperity and the Providence of God (Genesis 30:35-43)

God's revelation guided Jacob's success (Genesis 31:10-12)

God gives the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6-7)

God provides for those who seek His kingdom (Matthew 6:25-34)

Are we willing to obey God, even when His ways don't make sense?

IV. The Greater Prosperity in Christ

Jacob sought the Promised Land; we seek an eternal home (Hebrews 11:13-16)

True prosperity isn't wealth but belonging to Christ (John 10:27-28; Revelation 5:9)
